STANDING ORDER AS TO PROCEDURAL HANDLING OF RULE 4001, F. R. BK. P.,
PROPOSED AGREEMENTS RELATING TO RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY,
PROHIBITING OR CONDITIONING THE USE, SALE OR LEASE OF PROPERTY,
PROVIDING ADEQUATE PROTECTION, USE OF CASH COLLATERAL, AND
OBTAINING CREDIT

WHEREAS, prior to the advent of the current computerized CASE MANAGEMENT system in this court, one of the features of which is the converting of paper documents into electronic public access images, some rule 4001 practitioners have submitted proposed agreed orders in paperwork form, unaccompanied by motions for approval thereof, but including proposed language for interlocutory orders contemplating final hearings or agreed entries on the merits of such orders; and

WHEREAS, to better ensure due process consideration of the proposed stipulated relief sought by such agreed orders, as well as to better inform public access viewers as to the status of such pending matters, it is

ORDERED that any such proposed agreed rule 4001 order shall be appended as an exhibit to an agreed motion seeking court approval of such proposed order; and such motion shall be handled according to established due process procedures; and it is further

ORDERED that the entry of such a proposed agreed order shall await the disposition of the motion to which the proposed order is appended.
