## FILING AMENDED SCHEDULE(S) D, E/F – TO ADD CREDITORS

## FILING REQUIREMENTS

- Amended Schedule(s)
- Amended Creditor Matrix PDF should <u>only list</u> added creditors <u>or clearly</u> <u>indicate</u> added creditors;
  - Filer must also input added creditor(s) in Creditor Database;
- Notice to Added Creditor(s) Required <u>only if</u> §341 Meeting of Creditors Notice has been filed/docketed;
  - Fillable form available on Court's website;
  - Filer should attach a copy of the §341 Meeting of Creditors Notice;
- Filing Fee
  - Required except when changing address of existing creditor or adding an attorney for an existing creditor;

## FILING INSTRUCTIONS

## Docket Event: Bankruptcy > Other > Amended Schedule(s) D, E/F (Fee)

- 1. Upload all required documents listed above as one PDF document (or filer may upload matrix and notice as attachments);
- 2. When prompted, provide the following information:
  - a. Whether Schedule D is being amended and (if applicable) the total Secured Claim amount;
  - b. Whether Schedule E/F is being amended and (if applicable) the total Priority and Nonpriority Unsecured Claim amount(s);
  - c. Whether creditors are being added;
- 3. Input added creditors in the Creditor Database (<u>Docket Event</u>: **Bankruptcy** > **Creditor Maintenance**)

**NOTE**: An Amended Creditor Matrix and updated Creditor Database are required when a creditor is added to a bankruptcy case. <u>To avoid multiple filing fees</u>, the amended matrix must be filed with the amended schedules as described above.

• If the Amended Creditor Matrix is not included, the filer must file it separately and pay the required filing fee.
