




**ORDER REPEALING STANDING ORDER REGARDING:
(A) DISABILITY, IMPAIRMENT, DISBARMENT, OR SUSPENSION
OF DEBTOR'S COUNSEL OR (B) DEATH OF DEBTOR'S COUNSEL**

The U. S. Bankruptcy Judges of the Northern and Southern Districts of Mississippi signed a Standing Order Regarding: (A) Disability, Impairment, Disbarment, or Suspension of Debtor's Counsel or (B) Death of Debtor's Counsel (the "Standing Order") effective September 22, 2014. The Bankruptcy Judges have determined that the Standing Order is no longer necessary to govern procedures regarding disability, impairment, disbarment, suspension, or death of debtor's counsel. Accordingly, the Bankruptcy Judges of the Northern and Southern Districts of Mississippi do hereby repeal and rescind the Standing Order.


