
**AMENDED ORDER DESIGNATING THE BANKRUPTCY JUDGES OF THE  
NORTHERN DISTRICT OF MISSISSIPPI TO CONDUCT JURY TRIALS**

The United States District Court for the Northern District of Mississippi hereby specially designates the active bankruptcy judges of this district to conduct jury trials pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(e), which reads as follows:

“If the right to a jury trial applies in a proceeding that may be heard under this section by a bankruptcy judge, the bankruptcy judge may conduct the jury trial if specially designated to exercise such jurisdiction by the district court and with the express consent of all the parties.”

This order shall be entered nunc pro tunc, October 22, 1994, the effective date of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994.
